

## Pupil premium Impact

Pupil's eligible for free school meals, or those who have been eligible in the past six years are supported by additional funding in our school. We have used this funding to narrow the gap between the attainment of FSM pupils against non-school meals pupils.

Pupils who are Looked After ( in the care of the local authority) also receive additional funding. We also allocate support for our pupils with English as an additional language. Cohorts ( year groups) of pupils differ greatly within our setting and therefore staff track the progress of all groups at classroom level. Some pupils might be on FSM AND have Special Educational Needs, for example. Therefore we treat our data with caution and focus upon individual pupils within our small school setting.

At the end of Key Stage 2 in 2014 the following progress was made.

**Reading -** 75% of pupils reached Level 4+  
75% FSM's reached Level 4  
  
33.3% Level 5  
50% of FSM pupils achieved Level 5  
91.6% made 2 levels of progress from Key Stage 1 to 2  
5 pupils out of 12 made 3 levels of progress  
100% LAC pupil at Levels 4+
